The Kalamazoo Valley Racing Pigeon Club (KVRP) will be holding an annual Racing Pigeon show in conjunction with the Western Michigan Pigeon Association's (WMPA) annual show bird show. We are excited about these two areas of the pigeon fancy coming together in one show and hope to forward the pigeon hobby, show or racing, together. So, invite someone along. Tell someone about it. With your help we can certainly keep this "The best little show in Michigan!"

### Show Information

1. The KVRP Club meet will be held in conjunction with the WMPA 2018 All Breeds\All Age show on Saturday, November 3 at Drenthe Community Grove, 615 68<sup>th</sup> Ave, Zeeland MI 49464 (visit [www.wmpa.us](http://www.wmpa.us) for a map or just look for the big water just west of "Downtown" Drenthe.)
2. **Entries must be received by October 31<sup>st</sup>.** Mail entries to: Philip Huizinga, 300 West 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Holland, MI 49423 or via email to [phillyfish@juno.com](mailto:phillyfish@juno.com) (Please put "KVRP Show" in the subject line). For questions, leave a message, voice or text, at (616) 836-3470.
3. Setup is at 7:00 AM, check-in starts at 8:00 AM, and judging will begin at 9:30 AM. We could use help setting up around 7:30 AM.
4. Admission is free and open to the public.
5. There are two categories: "Show" and "Eye sign". You may enter the same bird in each category if you would like, but the entry fee applies to both. For example, if you wanted a bird judged in the "Show" category, that would be \$3.50. If you also wanted that same bird judged in the "Eye sign" category that would be another \$3.50. You may enter birds in either category or both. Juniors (14 years of age or under at the time of the show) may enter birds for \$1.50.
6. The classes within the two categories are Young Hen (hatched this year), Young Cock (hatched this year), Yearling Hen (hatched last year), Yearling Cock (hatched last year), and everything else is Old Hen, or Old Cock.
7. There will be ribbons and trophies for winners in the classes.
8. Water cups will be provided but you are responsible for watering your birds.
9. The KVRP Club will be holding an auction of birds donated by Scott Kliphuis and other members of the club.
10. The WMPA open show, along with the Rare Breeds Club and the Old German Owl club will be occurring at the same time as the KVRP Club show so come out and see all kinds of different pigeons and judging approaches!
11. The kitchen will again be open with great food at affordable prices.
12. We reserve the right to refuse any unhealthy specimen from the show or sale section.
13. WMPA\KVRP will not be held liable for any loss or injury during the show.
14. The judges' decisions are final! Please do not discuss your birds with the judges prior to or during the show and judging. After the show is finished I am sure the judges will be glad to answer any of your questions about your birds.
